APPEALS: First Batch of 572 completes Training, as Second Batch Commences Next Week

The first batch of three hundred and seventy-two (372) of Agro-Processing Productivity Enhancement and Livelihood Improvement Support Project (APPEALS) trainees from Kano State completed its training on agric value chains. The ceremony took place at the Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA) on Friday, 27th December, 2019.

This came on the heels of completing the first batch of 200 trainees from Kogi State.

The Director, Centre for Dryland Agriculture, Professor



Jibrin M. Jibrin, who was represented by the Deputy Director, Training at the closing ceremony, Professor Sanusi Gaya Mohammed, enjoined the beneficiaries to maximally use what they learned and put it into practice, noting that the CDA in partnership with its sister departments trained 72 on rice, 251 poultry and 49 on fisheries value chain. He congratulated them for being selected to participate in the two-week intensive training.

Earlier, the Managing Director of Kano Agricultural and Rural Development Authority (KNARDA), Alhaji Ibrahim Suleiman Dan Isle, congratulated the participants for earning the certificates from one of the top Africa centres of excellence and cautioned them to make a comprehensive business plan that would contribute meaningfully to the economic development of the State.

The Kano State Project Coordinator of APPEALS Project, Hassan Ibrahim, said the participants should count themselves lucky as 38, 282 people applied for the training, but only 1600 applicants were successful.

The Coordinator explained that the 1600 was distributed across three institutions with BUK and Kano University of Science and Technology given 600 participants each and Audu Bako College of Agriculture 400 trainees. He

commended the CDA for impacting positively on the lives of the trainees and assured that APPEALS would continue to partner with it.

The trainees took time to praise the CDA for capacitating them with modern methods of agricultural value chains that would add value to their livelihood and help them to become self-reliant.

Lubabatu Lawan (poultry) said she thanked Almighty Allah for the knowledge acquired and assured that she would use it to train others, especially women, to benefit. She also thanked the trainers for teaching her new methods of poultry farming.

Hajara Hamza (fisheries) said she was short of words to thank the APPEALS, BUK and CDA for taking her to the limelight of new knowledge of fish farming that would go a long way in helping her become self-reliant. She expressed the hope that it would boost the economy of the state.

On his part, Hudan Ahmad Abdullahi (rice) said he was proud of what he had learned and expressed gratitude to God for being selected out of thousand applicants.

Meanwhile the CDA had secured another approval to train another set of trainees from Kaduna State under the APPEALS project.

The second batch from Kano and Kogi State will commence their training next week.
