



ASUU-BUK Protests Pro-rata Salary, Presents Letter to VC ... We Protest Against Casualization of Intellectuals

Congress of Academic Staff Union of Universities (ASUU), Bayero University, Kano on Thursday, 17th November, 2022 protested against the Federal Government's handling of its members, especially the October 2022 pro-rata salary and purported pronouncement to make the university lecturers as casual staff.

The union described the government's attitude as illegitimate, saying it was vehemently protesting against casualization of intellectualism.

Presenting the protest letter to the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, on Thursday, 17th November, 2022 at the entrance of the Abubakar Rasheed

The Zonal Coordinator explained that after the suspension, the union at the end of October received a shocker of half salary paid to all its members. He said it was sad, describing the government's action as unjust and uncalled-for.

The protest action, according to him, was necessitated following a directive given by the ASUU NEC after it met and reviewed the whole situation.

According to the ASUU Coordinator, the crisis in the university sector was far from over giving the Federal Government's insensitivity in handling the union, saying that government was given many chances to fulfill its promises but failed to do so.

He urged the Vice Chancellor to use all available channels to inform the federal government, Committee of Nigerian Vice Chancellors, students bodies and all other stakeholders of the union's protest so that the government would do the needful.

“If the government fails to take the appropriate action, the union should not be held accountable if it takes decisive action,” he said.

Responding, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, who was represented by the

Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academics, Professor Sani Muhammad Gumel, commended ASUU for its resilience, doggedness and respect for law and order, saying it followed the right channel to protest its demands. “It shows you are a peace loving union,” the Vice Chancellor said.

The vice chancellor noted that when the union was on strike, activities in the universities were paralyzed, saying that in the last three weeks after suspension of the strike, academic activities and other business activities were brought back to normalcy.

He said in BUK all the progress recorded would not be achieved without the intervention of ASUU. He added that one of the secret successes of the university was harmonious relationship between the management and all the unions, including Student Union Government.

Senate Building, ASUU Kano Zonal Coordinator, Abdulkadir Mohammed, from Kano University of Science and Technology, said all ASUU branches in the country were mandated to conduct a peaceful protest to demand the government to address all the issues it signed with the union among which are renegotiation of FG/ASUU agreement, replacement of IPPIS and revitalization, among others. He said the protest was legitimate aimed at salvaging the university education.

He recalled that the union embarked on industrial action on 14th February, 2022 and after the intervention of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, Femi Gbajabamila, and the court injunction, the union suspended its 8-month old strike with the assurance from the Speaker that most of the contending issues would be addressed.

A. NOTE: JAMB 'O' LEVEL REQUIREMENT:

The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has indicated that it would not clear any shortlisted candidate who does not have 'O' Level results. All candidate therefore, are advised to visit any JAMB Office or Accredited CBT Centre nearest to them to upload their 'O' Level results (WAEC, NECO e.t.c.) on the Central Admission Processing System (CAPS).

Note that supplying false information will result in disqualification. Candidates are allowed to supply a maximum of two different 'O' Level examination results.

B. SCREENING:

Candidates who applied for admissions into Bayero University, Kano in the 2022/2023 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination conducted by Joint Admission and Matriculation Board (UTME) should be screened through an aptitude test.

You should then fill-in the provided form noting that the photograph uploaded from JAMB will be the only valid ID for all admitted candidates throughout their stay in Bayero University, Kano
- Step 3: Generation of BUK PPI** - Generate and download your Personalised Payment Invoice (PPI). The invoice will come with Remita Retrieval Reference (RRR) for the sum of ₦2,000.00 being cost of screening. Applicants have an option of paying online using Credit/Debit Card, Internet Banking, or printing the invoice and using it to pay at any Commercial Bank nationwide. Note that after successful online payment, acknowledgement slip can instantly be generated and printed. In case of bank payment, the payment have to be processed by the candidate using the provided "check your payment" button on the site, before acknowledgement card can be printed.

GUIDELINES FOR 2022 JUNIOR STAFF PROMOTION

To: All Provosts, Deans, Directors and Heads of Department/Units.

This is to request you to submit to the Junior Staff Unit, your recommendations for the 2022 annual promotions of Junior Staff in your Faculty, Departments/Sections/Units.

1. The candidate(s) being presented for promotion should be confirmed staff and must be qualified academically and professionally. Such staff must have demonstrated exceptional performance meriting promotion.
2. (a) He/she must have served the University for at least 3 years after his/her last promotion.
(b) **For the newly appointed he/she must be confirmed and spent at least three years by 30th September, 2022.**
3. (a) Candidate(s) for promotion to ranks on CONTISS 03 and 04 must have at least three (3) credits in SSCE/GCE or its equivalent, except **Motor Driver**.
(b) Candidate(s) for promotion to CONTISS 05 must have same as (a) above plus a relevant certificate, except **Driver/Mechanics, Artisans, Medical Records Assistant, Medical Technicians, Messenger/Cleaner, Gardner and Groundsmen**.
(c) Candidate for promotion to CONTISS 6 must have any of the following qualifications:
 - a. Two year Diploma in relevant fields;
 - b. Certificate in Public Administration/ plus three O/level credits;
 - c. Professional Diploma in Computer Studies/ plus three O/level credits;
 - d. Clerical Officer Certificate/ plus three O/level credits;
 - e. Assistant Library Officer Certificate/ plus three O/level credits;
 - f. Certificate in Science Laboratory Technology/ plus three O/level credits in science subjects;
 - g. Military Police Special Investigation Course II/ plus three O/level credits;
 - h. Except **Driver/Mechanics**.
4. Staff on study fellowship or who has been granted study fellowship **can be** presented for promotion once.
5. Staff with a **warning letter** in the last 6 months should not be presented for promotion.
6. All re-designation cases (upgrading, change of cadre and conversion) should not be presented to the Junior Staff A & PC, instead it should be directed to the Registrar.
7. Departments should not re-submit cases for promotion which were earlier rejected without acquiring the needed relevant qualification.
8. Staff posted to a new dept/unit must spend at least six months before the new unit can assess him/her for promotion. Staff affected by the recent redeployment should therefore, be assessed by their former head of department.
9. Only November/December O/level is acceptable for promotion after appointment.
10. Ten (10) copies of the attached forms should be completed and submitted in respect of each candidate.
11. All submissions and recommendations are to be submitted to the Junior Staff Office on or before **28th November, 2022**.

NB: Officers presenting candidates for promotion shall be required to come and defend their submissions before the Junior Staff A & PC with their departmental files and photocopies of relevant credentials on the scheduled date.
