## Faculty of Communication Holds Round Table Conference on Media Funding in Nigeria ...As Governor Ganduje Advocates Legal Framework for Journalism Profession

The Faculty of Communication, Bayero University conducted a Round Table Conference on Media Development and Sustainable Funding in Nigeria from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2022.

The Conference attracted professionals, academics, seasoned and veteran media technocrats, researchers and other stakeholders, who discussed extensively on the unbundling of mass communication and the sustainable means of funding the media industry in Nigeria.

In his remark, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, said the university was ever ready to accept the unbundling of mass communication to reflect the current dynamics and reality, adding that it would provide an avenue for mounting programmes such as journalism, development communication, broadcasting, advertising and film and media studies. He said the university would fully support the Faculty of Communication on these programmes.

The Vice Chancellor informed the participants that with the support of MacArthur Foundation, the university would soon unveil its television station having secured operational license, commending the foundation for its support in the establishment of digital radio FM and computer laboratory that accommodates 150 students.

Declaring the conference open, the Kano State Governor, Dr. Abdullahi Umar Ganduje advocated for promulgation of legal framework that will guide the operations and conduct of the media profession, as well as the registration

of the media houses. He said the framework would address the perennial challenges facing the media industry such as hate speeches, junk journalism and other unwarranted and biased reportage.

The convener of the conference and the Vice Chancellor of Federal University, Kashere, Professor Umar Pate, said the round table discussion brought together media executives, professionals and academia to chart a new course towards addressing funding and development challenges

bedeviling the mainstream media industry in Nigeria.

Professor Pate said the conference was an important gathering of media stakeholders to examine the issue of funding in media practice and the progress made so far on the unbundling of mass communication curriculum so as to address the myriad of problems affecting the media industry.

He said the unbundling of the curriculum was important because it will help in the training of the next generation of media practitioners that will be devoid of fake news and hate speech.

The lead paper presenter, Dr. John Momoh, disclosed in his presentation that the media industry is experiencing both

internal and external existential challenges in funding which bothers on integrity, safety of media workers, changes in tastes and expectations with social media compounding the woes of conventional media institutions already grappling with underfunding.

He said privately owned media houses are grappling with lack of funds while public media houses are in poor state economically with funds being misappropriated with employment of non-professionals.

He said innovation in media practice requires revenue that is now in short supply because audiences are now moving to online platform which has taken over advertising

The corrected hard copy (the paper version) must exactly match the disk version. Tables should be typed out on separate sheets and their position in the text indicated in Roman numerals. Art works, complete with proper captions, should be in finished form. The title of the article, author's name and address should appear on a separate title page. Authors should refer to themselves and any previous work of theirs in the third person.
