VC Charges Staff on Quality, Standards

Inline with preparation for the forth coming accreditation exercise, the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sagir Adamu Abbas has gone round some Faculties and Departments to see the level of their preparedness for the exercise.

He spoke on Wednesday, 5th January, 2022 while going round pointing out that quality and high standards are what make an institution to excel.

Professor Abbas who reaffirmed the determination of the University Management to provide facilities and other necessary supports to provide enabling environment conducive for teaching and research, explained that Bayero University had been known for its strict adherence

to stipulated guidelines and other regulations.

The Vice Chancellor further sensitized staff to ensure that everything was put in proper perspective as the University will soon present some programmes for accreditation, saying that already, the management had put so much resources and facilities for the exercise.

"It may interest you to note that in the last couple of months, we have expended hundreds of millions of naira in the provision of equipment, renovation of building, purchase of furnitures, ICT facilities as well as purchase of library materials both e-copies and hard copies of books and journals.

She rose to the position of Acting Deputy Director, Quality Assurance in the Directorate of Academic Planning. In February 2021, she was transferred to the Directorate of Establishment Matters as Deputy Registrar. The new Acting Director Holds a Master of Science Degree in Economics.

Malam Sheriff Ahmed was a former member of the Editorial Board, a columnist and Editor of the New Nigerian On Sunday. He joined Bayero University, Kano in 2014 and worked in General Administration and the office of the Registrar until March 2021 when he was deployed to the office of the Vice Chancellor as Deputy Registrar. The Executive Secretary of the National Universities Commission (NUC), and former Vice Chancellor of Bayero University, Professor Abubakar Adamu Rasheed has passed a vote of confidence on the Centre for Islamic Civilization and Interfaith Dialogue (CICID) for introducing programmes that will ignite collaboration with Islamic institutions globally.

Speaking on Wednesday, 29th December, 2021 at the Vice Chancellor's Office while receiving officials of the Centre,

Prof. Rasheed commended the Centre for publishing the proceedings of the Conference on Boko Haram which he said will go a long way in addressing security challenges.

The NUC Boss who commended the Centre for organizing a by-monthly public lecture, also urged them to continue with the conflict resolution programmes on interfaith and dialogue, describing it as part of intellectual efforts aimed

at unraveling the complexities surrounding Islamic conceptualization.

He said the proposal of the Centre to hold an international conference on Islamic Civilization in October 2022 is apt and would create an avenue for true Islamic conceptualization. He, therefore called on the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sagir Adamu Abbas to continue to support the Centre in achieving its mission.

He advised that, as part of the conference preparations, the Centre should organize a round table among all stakeholders in multidisciplinary fields aimed at proffering solutions to societal security challenges.

In his remarks earlier, Director of Centre for Islamic Civilization and Interfaith Dialogue (CICID), Dr. Sani Umar Rijiyar Lemo advocated for collaboration with local and international agencies for effective conflict resolution programmes and promotion of peace and harmony in the society.

The Director, appealed to the University Management to continue to support the Centre by providing a bus, a standby generator and e-library, said the Centre has recently championed collaboration with *Hisbah* Board in training its staff and other conflicts associated issues.

While responding to requests, the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sagir Adamu Abbas pledged to provide the needed facilities and support the Centre in organizing the international conference.

The gathering concluded with presentations of Islamic books to the NUC-ES, Prof. Abubakar Rasheed and the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sagir Adamu Abbas by the Director CICID, Dr. Sani Umar R/Lemo.

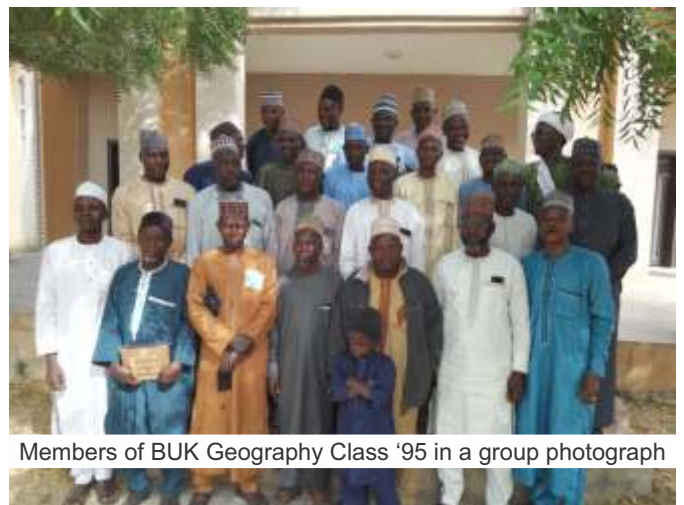
Geography BUK 1995 Alumni Honours Professor Ibrahim Badamasi Lambu and 10 Others
