University Autonomy Remains the only Panacea for Unstable Academic Calendar – Prof. Munzali Jibril

The Former Executive Secretary of the National Universities Commission (NUC), Emeritus Professor Munzali Jibril, has called for the promulgation of a legislation that will grant full autonomy to the nation's universities as a panacea for unstable academic calendar.

The erudite scholar made the suggestion in a keynote address titled: "Restoring Full Autonomy to Nigerian Universities," he delivered at this year's Quadrennial Conference of Alumni Associations of Nigerian Universities (CAANU), which took place on Saturday 3rd December, 2022 at the Convocation Arena, BUK New Campus.

According to him, "appropriate legislation should be passed to return universities to their autonomous status as grant-aided academic institutions rather than parastatals of government," he remarked.

He is optimistic that if this is achieved, it would go a long way to usher in the much needed industrial harmony, peace

and a stable academic calendar in the university system.

In his address, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas challenged delegates to the Quadrennial Conference to come up with strategies on how to deploy the power of alumni associations to rescue and strengthen the nation's struggling universities.

Professor Abbas was speaking shortly before he declared the CAANU opened. He observed that in developed countries, alumni associations had been most often the engine room of development of their Alma Mata through extensive infrastructural endowments, saying that with the will and determination, 'we can replicate such magnanimity here in the best interest of the development of our university system,' he stated.

The Vice Chancellor, who was represented by the University Librarian, Dr. Musa Auyo, welcomed the delegates to Bayero University, Kano and thanked them for giving the University the privilege of hosting this year's national Alumni conference.

Earlier in his address, the outgoing President of CAANU, Professor Ahmed Tijjani Mora, *mni* outlined some of the modest achievements of the association and appealed to members to maintain tempo.

Also speaking, the President of the Bayero University Kano Alumni Association (BUKAA), Dr. Nasirudeen Usman (*mni*) expressed the association's gratitude for the privilege of hosting the historic convention in BUK.

The CAANU also presented awards to some prominent citizens including the Governor of Kano State, Dr. Abdullahi Umar Ganduje, OFR, Prof Abubakar Adamu

Gwarzo of Maryam Abacha University Kano, late Professor Musa Abdullahi of BUK, Alhaji A. A. Rano and Alhaji Shuaibu Idris, mni.

BUK's Department of Education Holds 1st International Conference, Celebrates its Golden Jubilee

The Department of Education, Bayero University, Kano conducted its first international conference and celebrated golden jubilee with the theme: Inter-Disciplinary Review of Education Laws and Policies from 5th to 8th December, 2022.

Speaking on the occasion, the keynote speaker, Professor Rukayyatu Ahmad Rufai OON, who was represented by Professor Garba Sa'ad, said education laws are set to regulate education policies and programmes in line with provision of the constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (1999) as amended the national policy on education (NPE) was developed to support the actualization of provisions which were enshrined in 53,

article 18 where the government promised the provision of free education and literacy to its citizenry at all levels from primary to tertiary levels including adult literacy. The NPE sets out the philosophy and goals of education in Nigeria in line with national development objectives.

Professor Ahmed said this keynote presentation was however, geared towards strengthening the implementation of these laws and policies as it focused on the challenges facing implementation in Nigeria and provided several ideas and strategies for tackling such challenges.

Also speaking, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas, represented by the Provost, College of Natural and Pharmaceutical Sciences, Professor Tijjani Darma, commended the department for organizing the

conference as the theme of the conference was apt and timely. He expressed the hope that the proceedings would be used by the policy makers and government to solve some of the challenges facing this country in terms of laws and policy of education.

In his remark, his Excellency, the Executive Governor of Kano State, Dr Abdullahi Umar Ganduje OFR said his administration has done a lot in educational sector to the extent that 26.3% of its budget is being allocated to educational sector in line with the UNESCO standard.

Represented by the Chief of Staff, Alhaji Usman Bala Mohammed, the Governor expressed optimism that Kano State was ready to amend and implement any law and policy that would rejuvenate the education system in the state.

Also speaking, wife of Kano State Governor, Dr Hafsat Abdullahi, Umar Ganduje, who was represented by the Executive Secretary, Agency for Mass Education, Dr Halima Rabi'u Abdullahi, said Kano State government placed much premium on education by establishing schools and are renovating the existing ones, saying that recently the state government trained 630 women and youth on various skills and were given N10,000 each to support their businesses.

The Dean Faculty of Education, Dr Ali Idris and Head of Department of Education, Dr Muhammad Adamu Kwankawso both spoke on the historical evolution of the department and the prominent people that served and are currently serving as chief executives in various government ministries and agencies.

Goodwill messages were presented by some prominent Professors who served the department diligently including Professor Garba Dahuwa Azare, Professor Abdalla Uba Adamu, Professor M.Y Bichi, Professor, Professor Aliyu Dauda, Professor Shehu Magaji, Professor Tijjanai Ismail among others.

Highlight of the occasion was presentation of book in honour of the late Professor Danjuma Maiwada by the Chairman Local Organizing Committee, Professor Abdulrashid Garba and Professor M.I. Yakasai.

BUK to Admit Non-UTME Candidates for Part-Time Degree Programmes

Bayero University is set to admit candidates into part-time degree programmes who have not sat down for UTME, as the University Senate approved this policy at its 398th meeting held on 30th November, 2022.

In a statement signed by the Director, Examinations, Admissions and Records (DEAR) on major decisions taken at the Senate, said upon consideration, the Senate noted that JAMB had approved the policy and was endorsed by the National Universities Commission (NUC).

'The Senate approved the policy of admitting non-UTME candidates into part-time degree programmes and requested the School of Continuing Education to come up with a comprehensive proposal on the number of candidates to be admitted as well as quality control for consideration and approval,' the statement said.

In another development, the Senate noted that some members who were elected into various sub-committees at

the 396th meeting had proceeded on leave of absence or sabbatical while others had resigned from the services of the University.

CDA Director, Prof Jibrin Elected President Food for West Africa Network

The Director of the Centre for Dryland Agriculture (CDA), Professor Jibrin Mohammed Jibrin has been unanimously elected as the President of the Food for West Africa (FOOD4WA) network. FOOD4WA is a network of the agriculture-based Africa Centres of Excellence (ACEs) that brings together seven ACEs from six African countries whose activities focus on agriculture, food security and nutrition.

The network is currently working on strengthening of skills and training of young Africans who can take up the challenge of food self-sufficiency, and food and nutritional security. Additionally, the universities hosting the Centres will

The FOOD4WA had in August 2022 organized its first symposium hosted by the African Centre of Excellence in Agriculture for Food and Nutrition Security (CEA-AGRISAN), Cheikh Anta Diop University in Dakar (AGRISAN) in Dakar, Senegal.

Professor Jibrin has succeeded Professor Kokou Tona, the Centre Leader of the Africa Centre of Excellence in poultry Science (CERSA) of the University of Lomé, Togo.
