The appointments of the two erudite scholars were contained in two separate letters dated 19th January, 2023 and signed by the Registrar, Malam Jamil Ahmad Salim. It said the two appointees would serve for a period of two-years each with effect from 19th January, 2023.

According to the terms and conditions of the appointments, the new University Orator will serve as the presenter at Convocation Ceremonies of the University and may also act in the same capacity at other academic rituals, such as Inductions, Conferment of Honorary Degrees, Investitures, Inaugurations and such other ceremonies. It added that he would be responsible to the Vice Chancellor in conducting the affairs of the University Ceremonies and also required to report to the Vice Chancellor from time to time.

The new University Orator is a Professor of English and the Dean, School of Postgraduate Studies (SPS). He was also the immediate past Vice Chancellor of Yusuf Maitama Sule
